

ORAL HEALTH CARE FOR SCHOOL STUDENTS

Free dental care through the Child and Adolescent Oral Health School Dental Service) is offered to all Queensland students from the age of four to the completion of Grade 10 who is a permanent resident of Australia and named on a Medicare Card.

Students in **years 5 to 10** at Downlands College are being offered dental treatment. For day students, a dental registration form will be issued to each family. For boarding students a medical history form will be emailed home. If you would like your child/children to participate in the free dental care program, please complete each section of the form, sign and return it to the School Office by **Wednesday 29th March 2017**.

- Appointments are at Harlaxton School Dental Clinic, Lemnos St, Toowoomba. The dental van will not be at the school.
- There are limited appointments available before and after school and most appointments will have to be during school time
- Oral Health does not accept any responsibility for transport of the children to and from their appointments
- Parents/Legal Guardians are responsible for getting their child/children to all appointments.
- Appointments for boarders will be liaised through the School Health Centre.
